Our prayer Book calls us, "to the observance of a holy Lent, by selfexamination and repentance; by prayer, fasting, and self-denial; and by reading and meditating on God's holy Word." A Holy Lent, one that is given to God – set aside for God, can be accomplished in many ways. It need not only mean "giving up," it may in fact mean taking Through our self-Repentance calls us to "turn around" and move in the opposite direction. We can accomplish this through the means of prayer, fasting, and self- denial. Prayer renews our conversation with God, and directs us in all things. Fasting reminds us that we do not live by bread alone, and self-denial helps us to strengthen our resolve - to discipline our physical




